Rachel Watson is an alcoholic woman in her mid-thirties. She recently got divorced from her now-ex-husband Tom, and she's also lost her home and her job amid debilitating struggles with infertility, depression, and alcoholism. Rachel occupies herself by riding the train back and forth between London and her suburb of Ashbury each day because it offers a view of the back garden at her old home, 23 Blenheim Road in the suburb of Witney. Rachel enjoys spying on a gorgeous young couple who live a few doors down at 15 Blenheim Road and imagining what their lives must be like. One morning, Rachel spies the woman who lives in number 15 kissing another man on her terrace. She also has an affair with Tom Watson, whom she meets through babysitting his daughter Evie.
